SRMC & RI conducted the Founder-Chancellor, Thiru. N. P. V. Ramasamy Udayar Multi Specialty Free Medical Camp was conducted on 21st & 22nd September 2019 at Smt. Poovai Ammal Kalyana Mandapam, Rasipuram. Over 200 doctors and paramedical staff participated. Shri. R. V. Sengutuvan, Pro-Chancellor, Dr. S. Anandan, Dean-Medical College, Dr. K. Balaji Singh, Dean-Students, Dr. Suhas Prabhakar, Medical Director and Dr. N. Jambu, Medical Superintendent participated in the camp. 4117 patients benefited. Free spectacles were given to 150 members and 30 members were referred to Sri Ramachandra Hospital, Porur for free cataract surgeries. Hearing aids were provided for four members free of cost. Mammograms were done for 74 patients by *Penn Nalam* Hospital, Chennai.



Faculty members and interns from the Dept. of Public Health Dentistry, Faculty of Dental Sciences participated in the Founder-Chancellor Multispecialty Camp at Rasipuram on 21st & 22nd September 2019. A total of 611 patients were screened for oral problems. 304 patients underwent scaling and carious teeth were restored in 109 patients. All patients were provided free samples of toothpaste. Oral hygiene instructions were also given through audio-visual aids.



Dept. of Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge, Faculty of Dental Sciences participated in the Founder-Chancellor Multispecialty Camp at Rasipuram from 20th to 22nd September 2019. Eight faculty members and eight postgraduates attended the camp. 59 removable dentures were distributed. The final complete dentures were distributed by Shri. R. V. Sengutuvan, Pro-Chancellor, Dr. P.V. Vijayaragavan, Vice-Chancellor and Dr. K. Balaji Singh, Dean of Students. Oral hygiene instructions and maintenance of the removable prosthesis were explained by the Head of the Dept. and faculty members of Dept. of Prosthodontics to the patients. A one month review has been planned to ensure their satisfaction with the dentures.
